We are reaching out with yet another update as we continue to adjust our business operation and service we provide to our community as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. We are conducting business by appointment only to limit contact with others in an effort to protect you and our staff while doing our best to continue to help animals and be a resource to our community.

As you read earlier, all of the animals in our care have been moved to foster homes. The animals that are available for adoption through foster can be found at [www.ebhs.org](http://www.ebhs.org) under the ADOPT tab.

**If you would like to pursue adopting an animal:**

\*Complete our adoption application and send to us via email at [Elmbrookhs@ebhs.org](mailto:Elmbrookhs@ebhs.org), fax at 262-782-3356, or mail at 20950 Enterprise Avenue, Brookfield, 53045. Open the application, save to your computer, complete the application, save the file, and send via one of the options above.

\*Our staff will process your application and reach out to you to conduct a counseling session over the phone. If adoption is pursued, we will set up an appointment for you and any family members to visit us.

\*When you arrive for your adoption appointment, please call us at 262-782-9261 so we can open our facility for you.

Our office and adoption hours are currently 9AM-2PM Monday – Sunday.

**As a reminder:**

\*We have temporarily suspending soft paw applications. If you are in dire need of this service, please call us and we will work to help you.

\*If you need to surrender your pet, our same process will continue which has always been by appointment. We ask if at all possible right now, to continue to care for your pet. If you need to surrender, please visit <http://www.ebhs.org/index.php/animal-surrender> and follow the guidelines you will find at this link.

\*If you are in need of utilizing our Fix It! program (low cost spay and neuter program), please call us so we can help you via phone.

\*If you find a stray animal, please call us at 262-782-9261 so we can attempt to try and reunite the lost animal with its family. If we are unable to reunite the animal with its family, we will schedule an appointment for the animal to arrive at our facility or pick up the animal from you (if from one of the municipalities we are contracted to provide services to and if not, we will let you know who to contact).

\*If you need to reclaim your lost animal, we will be scheduling an appointment with you.

\*If you find an injured or sick lost or wild animal, please call us 262-782-9261 so we can work together to help the animal.

\*If you are in a position to help us by donating items from our wish list, donations can be left near our front door. If a donation receipt is needed, please email us at [Elmbrookhs@ebhs.org](mailto:Elmbrookhs@ebhs.org) or call us 262-782-9261 and we will email or mail you a donation receipt. Our most urgent needs are:

- Disinfecting wipes
- Bleach
- Laundry soap
- Paper toweling
- 13 and 55 gallon trash bags
- Canned cat, dog, kitten, and puppy food – pate for cats and kittens preferred and higher quality for all preferred
- Dry cat, kitten, and puppy food – higher quality preferred
- Scoopable cat litter
- Cheese slices
- Hot dogs
